## The Madeleine School Fund Campaign 2024 Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What is The Madeleine School Fund? The Madeleine School Fund is the primary source of funding for our Tuition Assistance and Endowment Funds, which provide assistance to all students with financial need. It also encompasses our Area of Greatest Need which is vitally important to bridge the gap between tuition and the true cost of education.
- 2. How will the school use The Madeleine School Fund donations? Your gift helps fund the difference between the cost of tuition and the cost of educating each child and enables all students to receive a Catholic education regardless of their family income. Your gift of \$9,500 pays tuition for one child for one year, \$792 for one month and \$183 for one week.

With everyone working together, The Madeleine will continue as a thriving, well-funded, Catholic school for the next 100 years. How much you give is not as important as your participation.
