

*Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.*

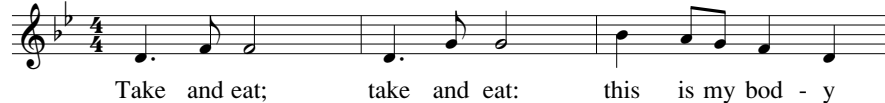
