With your generosity, we raised more than \$167,000. We are immensely grateful to the OCF Joseph E. Weston Foundation for their annual support, matching donations to our tuition assistance and endowment funds. A \$63,633 Weston Grant brings the total raised during the 2023 Campaign to more than \$230,000.



The Niedermeyer family has a long history with The Madeleine. While Ben attended The Madeleine as one of nine children, his dad, also named Ben, graduated from The Madeleine in 1935. He was the oldest of 15 children who all attended The Madeleine.

From this brood sprang another generation numbering over 100. Many of these cousins attended The Madeleine from the 1950s through the 1980s. Among the many good memories of the neighborhood and the school, Ben has a strong sense of gratitude for two Holy Name Sisters who taught him, Sister Celeste Marie (first grade) and Sister Louis James (seventh grade). He and several classmates recently visited both Sisters at a reunion in Portland.

Joanne also attended Catholic grade and high schools in Tacoma. Both Joanne and Ben attended Catholic colleges with Joanne graduating from Gonzaga University (1973) and Ben from Carroll College (1973).

The Madeleine is included in their annual giving in the spirit of gratitude for the education Ben received. They recognize the financial strain Catholic education faces today due to the absence of low-cost religious faculty members, such as nuns. With the school now relying on fairly compensated lay faculty, providing quality education requires a larger financial commitment. Ben and Joanne hope their donations will assist families in offsetting some of these increased costs, enabling more students to benefit from The Madeleine's education.

Ben and Joanne's parents were known for their generosity and imbued their children with this value. Their attitude was simply "the more you give, the better your life will be." Ben and Joanne both believe this and would add that it is important to give now, if you can, and not to wait.

We are grateful to Ben and Joann for the gifts they have given to The Madeleine over the years as well as all our donors who so generously give to The Madeleine School Fund. Thank you!
