The RCIA (the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is the process for welcoming adult newcomers into the Catholic Church.

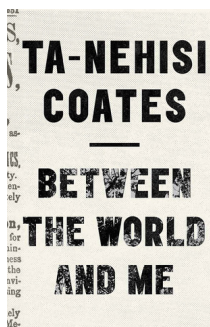

ALLELUIA!

The Gospel Acclamation

The word, "Alleluia" or "Hallelujah"

literally means "Praise the Lord." Because of that, it makes sense that during the Mass, the singing of the "Alleluia" occurs before the proclamation of the Gospel. Thus, it is often referred to as the "Gospel Acclamation."

The choir or cantor sings it first. The congregation then repeats it. Then, for good measure, the cantor sings a short scriptural verse in between the two choruses. For the record, because Lent is a penitential time in our Church year, we don't sing the "Alleluia" AT ALL during those 40 days prior to Easter.

In the early Church, the Gospel Acclamation was considered a moment of musical "freedom" in the Mass – where the cantor could add verses at will and even the choir could elaborate at the end of the antiphon. Most often the singers used a technique called "melisma,"

which means singing more than one note per syllable – in this case, many notes! As

you can imagine, as the Alleluia and its verses became more complicated the higher powers had to reign in the singers, and suggested that the text of the verses would be more clear by singing only one note per syllable. Even so, these elaborate Gospel Acclamations developed into

what we now call the Sequence, which can be very long. After Vatican II, only four sequences were kept in the Liturgy. At The Madeleine, you will regularly hear the Sequence chanted at Easter and Pentecost.

This weekend we are singing the Alleluia from the Mass of St. Mary Magdalene. It is joyful, short, and easy to sing – the perfect way to say "Praise the Lord!"

In Memoriam

THE MADELEINE FAMILY REMEMBERS

EILEEN ROSE LOPEZ

A funeral Mass and Rosary were held with family for longtime parishioner Eileen Lopez on Friday, September 18 at The Madeleine

Eileen Rose (O'Neill) Lopez, 93, died Sept. 15 in Portland. A memorial Mass will be planned after gathering restrictions ease.

Mrs. Lopez was born, the third of four children, to Thomas and Anna O'Neill on Sept. 17, 1926, in Cincinnati, Ohio. In 1928 her family moved to Detroit, Michigan where she attended St. Martins elementary and secondary school and graduated from Marygrove College in 1948. After graduating she worked for several years and enjoyed traveling, including trips to Rome and Cuba.

In 1954, she joined the Army and earned her physical therapy certification at Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio, Texas. First Lieutenant O'Neill was then stationed at Madigan Army Hospital, in Tacoma, Washington, where she met Captain Alonzo J. Lopez, a fellow member of the church choir. They married in

1956, settled in Tacoma and began welcoming their first five children. In 1964 the family moved to Medford, Oregon, adding two more children. In 1967 they moved to Northeast Portland, where they were blessed with their eighth child. Eileen stayed home with her children, running her busy household. She later returned to work as a physical therapist. She retired from Meridian Park Hospital after 25 years of service.

Eileen was devoted to her Catholic faith, demonstrating this through the care and love she gave to her family and church. She taught her children the importance of good nutrition, a strong work ethic, the value of a dollar, and staying faithful to their Catholic roots. As the mother of eight she was unwavering in her efforts to provide equally for each of them. She took immense pride in her family and her greatest joy was spending time with them. She was a parishioner at The Madeleine for 53 years, during which time she was member of the Altar Society, served as a Eucharistic minister and sang

both in the church choir and the Hallelujah Chorus.

Mrs. Lopez was preceded in death by her husband. She is survived by her children, Mary

Theresa, Timothy, Anna Maria, Mary Eileen Loftin, Mary Cecilia English, Christopher, Patricia and Mary Catherine. She will be greatly missed by her family including her grandchildren, Gabriel, Joseph, Richard, Jane, Emily, Claire, Matthew, Michael, Oscar, and Quanah.
