

SIGN UP FOR CHRISTMAS AND CHRISTMAS EVE MASSES

Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Mass registrations are now open. Because of limited attendance due to COVID restrictions, we have added additional Mass times as compared to past years.

With the limited spaces, we request that you sign up for only one Christmas Eve or Christmas Mass, and that you sign up with the intent of attending, and in the number of people you expect to attend.

As you can see above, two Masses are full (4:00 pm and 6:00 pm)...but we have many other Masses available.

Extensive COVID precautions will be in place, including mandatory mask/face coverings, social distancing, sanitizing and restrictions on the number of parishioners in attendance.

MUSIC FOR THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

This week marks the fourth Sunday of Advent. In our liturgical calendar, the readings at this time—no matter which cycle we are in—always focus on Mary, and our thoughts turn to the birth of Christ. Often called the "the first disciple," Mary reminds us to say "yes"

Mary reminds us to say "yes" with abandon to the will of God—even in times when we might be uncertain or afraid. In fact, as Mary shows us, it is precisely those times in our life when our faith is the strongest.

This week's Psalm 89 says "Forever I will sing the goodness of the Lord." It is officially called the "Lament over God's Promise to David," and was originally not a psalm of joy at all! What, then does this psalm have to do with Mary? Well, perhaps we can take our cue from Mary



- who joyfully proclaimed to the Angel Gabriel, "may it be done to me according to your word," - when she most certainly would have had feelings of fear and anxiety. If so, then it makes sense that on this Fourth Sunday of Advent we will proclaim Psalm 89 with

joy and thanksgiving no matter what our circumstance!

The psalmist (or cantor), takes time for silent reflection before proclaiming the Responsorial Psalm. We call this sacred silence. Its musical equivalent is called a rest, which is as important as singing the notes! And while a few seconds can seem like an eternity when on the altar, it is important for everyone to rest spiritually before the proclamation of the Psalm.

POPE FRANCIS PROCLAIMS "YEAR OF ST JOSEPH"


In an new Apostolic Letter entitled Patris Corde ("With a Father's Heart"), Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph as a beloved father, a tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows.

The Letter marks the 150th anniversary

of Blessed Pope Pius IX's declaration of St Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To celebrate the anniversary, Pope Frncis has proclaimed a special "Year of St Joseph," beginning on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception 2020 and extending to the same fest in 2021.

Mark's Gospel: The Whole Story

We read Mark at Sunday Eucharist in the 2021 liturgical year. This Bible study will take a fresh look at this gospel, its cycles of oral tradition, its use of story, and will pay special attention to women's presence as disciples. Participants will learn skills for deepening their own reading and interpretation of the gospels.

Course sessions will use *Mark's Gospel: The Whole Story* by Joan Mitchell, and the New Testament. Via Zoom, the 90-minute sessions will include presentation and small and large group conversation and activities.

- Jan 21 Read the introduction to Mark's Gospel: The Whole Story, pp. 4-12.
- Jan 28 Read *Whole Story*, Chapter 1, pp. 13-16; also Mark 1.1 and Mark 16.1-20 and Whole Story, Chapter 2, pp. 17-20. Also Mark 1.2-13.
- Feb 4 Read Whole Story, Chapter 3, pp. 21-27. Also Mark 1.14—3.35. Jesus' women disciples.
- Feb 11 Read Whole Story, Chapter 7, pp. 50-54. Also Mark 1.12-13 and 8.22—9.8.

No classes during the first weeks of Lent.

- Mar 25 Read *Whole Story*, Chapter 10, pp. 73-83. Also Mark 14.1-15.47, Palm/Passion Gospel. In memory of the anointing woman.
- Apr 1 Read Whole Story, Chapter 11, pp. 84-88. Also Mark 16.1-8, Easter Vigil Gospel.
- Apr 8 Read Whole Story, Chapter 4, pp. 28-32. Also Mark 4.1-34.
- Apr 15 Read *Whole Story*, Chapter 5, pp. 33-41. Also Mark 4.35—6:33; 6.45-51.
- Apr 22 Same readings as for April 15.
- Apr 29 Read Whole Story, pp 42-49. Also Mark 6.34-44; 6.52—8.21.
- May 6 Read Whole Story, Chapter 7, pp. 50-59. Also Mark 8.22—10.52.
- May 13 Read Whole Story, Chapter 8, pp 60-67. Also Mark 11.1—12.44. Read Whole Story, Chapter 9, pp 68-72. Also Mark 13.1-37.


