More than 70 people are already signed up...don't wait too long! Join us for a special Virtual Retreat featuring legendary Catholic musician Dan Schutte—one of the best-known and most influential composers of Catholic music for liturgy in the English-speaking world.

Dan's theological training includes Jesuit formation and two master's degrees – in theology and liturgy respectively – from the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley, California. In addition, he has three honorary doctoral degrees for his contribution to the life of the Church. Currently, Dan is composer-in-residence at the University of San Francisco.

As a musician, some of his most celebrated songs—"Here I Am, Lord," "City of God" and "Sing a New Song"—are from his years of collaboration with the St. Louis Jesuits. These songs, and many others, are truly part of the life-blood of Catholic repertoire in the post-Vatican II age. To honor that legacy, in 2017 OCP released the 40th anniversary edition of *Earthen Vessels*, as well as a beautifully remixed and remastered commemorative edition of their classic Christmas album, *Gentle Night*.

While Dan has served as liturgist and music director in various pastoral and academic settings, he spends a significant amount of time each year traveling to offer concerts, retreats, workshops and parish missions to communities throughout the country. Without missing a beat in the year of COVID, Dan has adapted his in-person retreats to a powerful virtual format.

This unique retreat opportunity is a synthesis of Dan's knowledge of Sacred Scripture, exquisite videography, and beautiful music. You can experience this retreat virtually with Dan in three consecutive one-hour sessions. As a bonus, Dan will join us for a 30-minute "meet and greet" on our final session.

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

AS WE ENTER INTO THE SEASON of Ordinary Time, we are invited to live deeper into our relationship with Jesus. 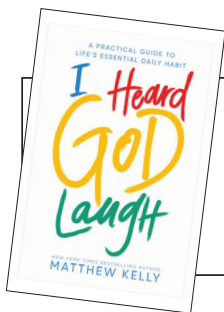

HERE I AM, LORD

This week we are officially back in Ordinary Time. The Christmas trees are down, the lights and decorations put away for another year—and for the next couple weeks our readings focus on the call to discipleship.

There is, perhaps, no better hymn that describes both the calling and following of Jesus than Dan Schutte's memorable "Here I am, Lord."

The words of the refrain are echoed this week in both Psalm 40 and in the First Reading from the book of Samuel. One of the most unique aspects of this hymn is the change in point of view that occurs between the verses and refrain. The verses speak from the perspective of God "calling" on us to be disciples – the refrain are those Christians "following" God's call. Further, the verses reflect a paradox. "Sea and sky," "snow and rain," "wind and flame," are descriptive of an all-powerful God. And it is God who can change darkness into light and



melt "hearts of stone." Finally, each verse ends with a question; "whom shall I send?" at which point, the answer is always "Here I am, Lord."

That insight into scripture through song is one of the many reasons that I believe Dan Schutte's music has stood the test of time for the last 50 years.

"Here I am, Lord," and many others, have truly been a part of the fabric of our liturgies since Vatican II.

Beginning January 26, you will have an opportunity to experience firsthand the marriage of scripture and music of Dan Schutte by participating in a Virtual Retreat with us here at The Madeleine.

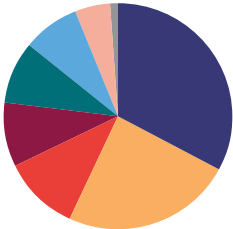


Support the Catholic Communication Campaign

This valuable resource was made possible through the Catholic Communication Campaign. By participating in the campaign, you help foster dialogue around the country on important faith and community issues.



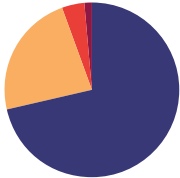


