In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus says: "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." As disciples, we are called to continue God's work on earth. Taking care of God's poor is indeed living gospel values. Have you considered answering the call to serve the poor by joining the Society of St. Vincent de Paul?

FISHERMEN OF MEN

Our little rescue dog, Frankie, has struggled with learning the word,

"come." He will do it, eventually, but is always hesitant—his heart is willing but he has to think about it first.

Of course, this type of behavior is in stark contrast to the gospel this week when Jesus encounters Simon, Andrew, James and John fishing at the Sea of

Galilee. Jesus said, "Come...., and I will make you fishers of men." No hesitancy there—they immediately abandoned their nets and followed him.

Throughout the gospels, Jesus chooses ordinary people with everyday occupations to be his closest allies. The imagery of the fishermen is easy to understand and to relate to. Just as the apostles were called to "drop their nets" and follow Jesus, today we are also called to be "fishers of men."

This week's gathering song, "Two Fishermen," by Suzanne Toolan, is a descriptive example of this gospel reading. Much like Dan Schutte's, "Here I am, Lord," the song offers two points of view. The first is that of the narrator,

who tells the story of Jesus and the Fishermen through each verse of the song. The second is that of Christ, who reminds us in the refrain to "leave all things behind, and come and follow me." Finally, in the last verse the narrator turns the attention toward us. We are summoned to "follow

Jesus" and leave all things that bind us to "trappings" of today.

How do you answer God's call? Are you hesitant, like our little dog Frankie? Or do you "drop your nets" and follow Christ with certainty and abandon.

One tangible way to answer God's call is to participate in the upcoming Dan Schutte Virtual Retreat which begins on Tuesday, January 26.
