## Lighting the Rose Candle

Traditionally, Advent wreaths are constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which four candles are inserted, representing the four weeks of Advent. Ideally, three candles are purple, and one is rose, but white candles can also be used.

The purple candles symbolize the prayer, penance, and preparatory sacrifices and goods works undertaken at this time.

The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday, Gaudete Sunday, when the priest also wears rose vestments at Mass; Gaudete Sunday is the Sunday of rejoicing, because the faithful have arrived at the midpoint of Advent, when their preparation is now half over, and they are close to Christmas.

The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope surrounding our Lord's first coming into the world and the anticipation of his second coming to judge the living and the dead.

## MUSIC NOTES WITH MARIA MANZO: REJOICE!

This weekend, we celebrate two joyous occasions amidst the season of Advent—Gaudete Sunday and The Solemnity of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

Gaudete Sunday is always the third Sunday of Advent in our Liturgical year.

“Gaudete,” which means “Rejoice,” is taken from Philippians

4:4,5 (this week’s second reading) “Gaudete in Domino semper” or “Rejoice in the Lord always.” Similar to the seventh inning stretch in baseball, it is a time when we can take a break from the more penitential character of the season, and look forward with joyful anticipation to the “home stretch” of the Lord’s coming at Christmas.

This Sunday also marks the Feast Day of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Technically, because it falls on a Sunday this year (a rare occurrence) this Feast Day should not overshadow the Third Sunday of Advent (I am honestly not sure who makes all of these decisions), but her importance as the Patron Saint of Mexico and the Patroness of the Americas should definitely NOT be overlooked! Tradition has it that Mary appeared to Juan Diego, an Aztec convert to Christianity, in the hills of Tepeyac on December 9 and again on December 12, 1531. During the apparition, Mary asked Juan Diego to go to the bishop and request a church be built atop Tepeyac Hill. The Bishop (sort of a “doubting Thomas”) asked for a sign before he would approve the construction of the church. So Mary appeared a second time, telling Juan Diego to go and collect roses and take them to the Bishop. When Juan Diego opened his cloak, dozens of roses fell to the floor and revealed the image of Mary imprinted on the inside of the cloak or Tilma (as it is called). Today, millions of pilgrims travel to Tepeyac to reverence the Tilma in the Basilica of Guadalupe, often doing so on their knees to express their devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe.

With so much joyful anticipation this weekend, it is no coincidence (my mother would, in fact, call it a “God”-incidence) that this Sunday also marks the return of “Bravo! Concerts Northwest” to The Madeleine. Prior to the pandemic, the performance of Handel’s “Messiah” was an Advent tradition and a staple to our concert

series—having performed over 50 concerts of this great work in the past 28 years. That is a lot of “Hallelujah!” choruses! In a nutshell, Handel’s “Messiah” is an oratorio (or Sacred Drama) in three sections that tell that story of Christ’s birth, death and resurrection. At nearly three hours in its entirety, it is a “tour de force” for choir, orchestra, and soloists. This year, our Bravo! “Concert of Hope” will include just the first section of “Messiah,” sometimes referred to as the “Christmas Section” since the musical text (predominantly from the scriptures of Isaiah and Malechi, as well as Luke and Matthew), cover the entire seasons of Advent and Christmas in less than one hour! For good measure, this concert

will also feature some of the finest soloists and guest jazz artists in the region—and a few familiar carols to put you in the holiday spirit. And, of course—the “Hallelujah!” chorus!

Yes, this Gaudete Sunday is truly a time to rejoice—by honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe, hearing the joyous strains of Handel’s Messiah and other holiday music—and looking forward with joyful hope for the coming of our Lord, Jesus Christ!

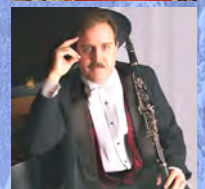
