
TIPS FOR GREEN LIVING



THE MADELEINE FAMILY REMEMBERS

MARY ELIZABETH WILLS

A Funeral Mass will be held for Mary Elizabeth Wills on Tuesday, May 17, 10:30 am, at The Madeleine.

Mary Elizabeth Wills (aka 'Beti') went to heaven to be with our Lord on April 8, 2022. A beloved sister, aunt, and friend to many. She will be remembered for her infectious sense of humor, as well as for her love and devotion for friends and family. Beti is survived by her sister Jenny, her brother Randy and his wife Janet, her niece Samantha, nephew Nathaniel, stepmother Gwen Wills, and dog Pearl.

Beti was born in Chicago to Paul and Janet Wills, the second of three children. She grew up in Arlington Heights, IL where she attended Our Lady of the Wayside grade school, Arlington High School, and attended St. Norbert's college in Wisconsin. She began a marketing career with GTE Directories, and in 1984 relocated to Arlington, TX. In 1990, Beti arrived in Portland, OR where she continued her career in graphic printing, consulting, design, engineering, and project management.

Beti was a fantastic athlete. In high school, she excelled in basketball and softball. She was the first female athlete in the State of Illinois to pitch a no-hitter in fast-pitch softball. In Portland, she continued to excel in softball, and she joined and fell in love with dodgeball. One of Beti's all-women teams won the National Dodgeball Championship in Las Vegas.

To say Beti had a great sense of humor is a serious understatement; she is perhaps one of the funniest people ever to grace the earth. Secretly, she longed to be a writer for Saturday Night Live, where she would have excelled. In addition to sharing

herself with those around her, she adopted social media as a forum, where she entertained her friends and family daily – sharing her experiences and observations (and opinions!) in a way that only Beti could.

Beti loved to build things – as part of her profession, and as part of her personal life. She was highly skilled in a variety of disciplines, and renowned for her ability to tackle and complete household projects – some for herself, but many



for others ("hey whatcha doing Saturday? Want me to build you a new deck?"). Her legacy lives on via a Portland based organization called 'Girls Build' (girlsbuild.org).

Perhaps most importantly, Beti loved to build and grow relationships. She cared deeply for her friends, of which she had many. The first to go out of her way to help someone – that was her style.


