Green Tips for a More Sustainable Lifestyle



RANDALL JAMES FOOTE

A Funeral Mass will be held for Randall James Foote on Friday, August 12, 10:00 am at The Madeleine.

Randy was born in Portland, Oregon to John Henry and Mary Ellen Foote. He grew up in the Woodstock neighborhood of Portland and attended Cleveland High School, where he lettered in baseball and cross-country. He graduated from Simon Fraser University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in English. He then spent over a decade as a touring musician/percussionist with, most notably, the Hudson Brothers. In the 80s Randy was signed as a recording artist releasing albums on Warner Brothers and Atlantic Records with bands, "The Dig" and "ComboNation." He later moved back to his hometown Portland,

Oregon where he started his own group, Randy Foote and The Skankin' Yankees.

He is survived by his brother, Jim, daughter,

Molly and his son Andrew.
