**Music Ministry Opportunities** 

- Madeleine Parish Choir: The Madeleine Choir is the heart and soul of the Music Ministry program. Rehearsals are weekly and the choir sings regularly at the 10:00 am Sunday Mass, as well as for special musical programs and feast days throughout the year.
- **The Madeleine Chimes Choir:** Hand chimes are instant musical gratification. Rehearsals are on Wednesdays as scheduled.
- Parish Cantors: The Parish Cantors lead the singing at liturgies, and sing in our Madeleine Choir. If you are an experienced singer, and looking for an extra musical challenge, consider auditioning to become a Parish Cantor.

- ▶ The Madeleine Children's Choir: Our Parish Children's Choir is open to all parishioners and school children, grades three-five (grade two by permission). The Children's Choir rehearses on Wednesdays, sing at the Family Masses, Grotto, and other special parish activities.
- > The Madeleine Youth Singers/Jr. Cantors: New this year, The Madeleine Youth Singers is open to all middle and high school youth. Rehearsals are on Thursdays. Youth will sing every other month at the 5 pm Mass on Saturday; and be trained as Cantors for the monthly Family Masses. In 2023-24, plans are to be part of the Pueri Cantores Festival Choir, with opportunities to sing either in the U.S. or abroad. Please note: Confirmation Candidates will receive Service Credit for singing in this ensemble and/or being a Jr. Cantor.
