## CONFIRMATION NOW OPEN TO 7<sup>TH</sup> & 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE YOUTH—REGISTER NOW

First Meeting September 18 • Please register no later than September 25

Archbishop Sample has announced a change in the age of Confirmation in the Archdiocese of Portland. With this announcement he stated:

*“This decision was made motivated by the desire that our youth receive the gift of the Holy Spirit as they transition through adolescence into adulthood and then exercise the graces of Confirmation through meaningful Christian ministry during their high school years. It is also to ensure an increase in confirmed Catholics. From a pastoral perspective, there has also been the need to correct the erroneous perception that Confirmation is tantamount to graduation and the concept that Confirmation was a personal choice of the candidate, rather than the freely given gift of the Holy*

*Spirit who desires all the Baptized to share actively in the Paschal Mystery as authentic witnesses of Jesus in the world.”*

In response to this announcement The Madeleine Confirmation Program will be provided in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade in our parish school. Parish youth who are not attending The Madeleine School are joyfully welcome to join our parish Confirmation program for 7<sup>th</sup>–12<sup>th</sup> graders.

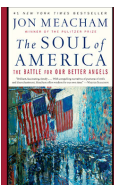

## RECYCLING PROGRAMS AT THE MADELEINE

The Madeleine's Laudato Si' Circle and Care for Creation Ministry have joined with U. S. based recycler, Terracycle, to offer our parish, school, and community opportunities to responsibly recycle specific items (primarily plastics) not generally handled at curbside. Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Do not include garbage or items not specifically mentioned in the descriptions.
- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.



### DISCONTINUED: STYROFOAM/ POLYSTYRENE

*Regrettably, we can no longer accept Styrofoam and Polystyrene materials. Although endorsed by Metro, we have recently learned (through an independent report) of major violations by the local recycler in the responsible handling and recycling of these materials.*

#### Music Ministry Opportunities

- ▶ **Madeleine Parish Choir:** The Madeleine Choir is the heart and soul of the Music Ministry program. Rehearsals are weekly and the choir sings regularly at the 10:00 am Mass every Sunday, as well as for special musical programs and feast days throughout the year. This choir is a vibrant, supportive faith community that sings, prays, and plays together!
- ▶ **The Madeleine Chimes Choir:** Hand chimes are instant musical gratification—an accessible way to make music as a group. Rehearsals are on Wednesdays as scheduled. A basic knowledge of rhythm is helpful, but not required. Ask any “chimer.” Playing hand chimes is just plain fun!!
- ▶ **Parish Cantors:** The Parish Cantors lead the singing at liturgies,

and sing in our Madeleine Choir. If you are an experienced singer, and looking for an extra musical challenge, consider being a Parish Cantor. This is an auditioned ministry.

- ▶ **The Madeleine Children's Choir:** All children love to sing! Our Parish Children's Choir is open to all parishioners and school children, grades three–five (grade two by permission only). The Children's Choir rehearses on Wednesdays, sings at the Family Masses, Grotto, and other special parish activities.
- ▶ **The Madeleine Youth Singers/Jr. Cantors:** NEW this year, The Madeleine Youth Singers is open to ALL middle and high school youth. Rehearsals are on Thursdays. Youth will sing every other month at the 5 pm Mass on Saturday; and be trained as Cantors for the monthly Family Masses. In 2023-24, plans are to be part of the Pueri Cantores Festival Choir, with opportunities to sing either in the U.S. or abroad. Please note: Confirmation Candidates will receive Service Credit for singing in this ensemble and/or being a Jr. Cantor.

DEAR CATECHISTS AND TEACHERS, DEAR FRIENDS,

I greet you with affection in the name of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Teacher.

“Teacher!” What a beautiful name this is! Jesus is our first and greatest teacher. Saint Paul tells us that Jesus gave his Church not only apostles and pastors, but also teachers, to build up the whole body in faith and love. You teach what Jesus taught, you instruct adults and help parents to raise their children in the faith, and you bring the joy and hope of eternal life to all. Thank you for your dedication, your example, your closeness to God’s people in their daily lives, and all the many ways you plant and nurture the seeds of faith throughout this vast land. Thank you especially for teaching our children and young people how to pray.

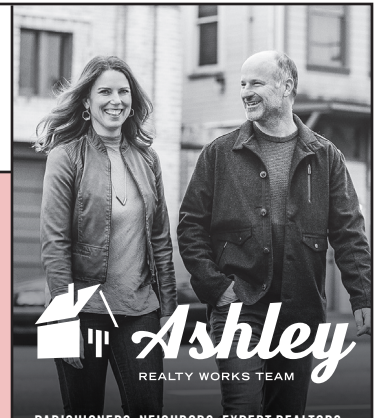
