


MAIN CHURCH INTERIOR PAINTING TO COMMENCE JANUARY 23

- But what about Masses of January 28 and **29?** We will hold Masses that weekend




likely in the Parish Hall, including that Sunday's Family Mass that kicks off Catholic Schools Week.


ORDINARY TIME




