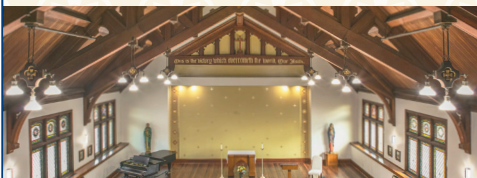

COMMUNAL PENANCE SERVICE, FEBRUARY 16

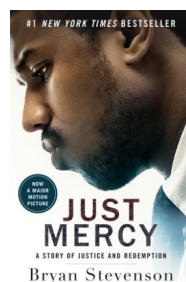
After a couple years without due to the pandemic, we are pleased to again offer our Communal Penance Service this spring.

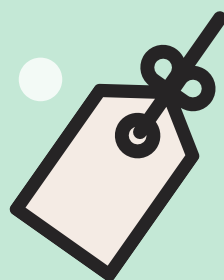

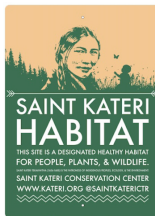
The gender specific competition is open to boys and girls ages 9 thru 14. Prizes will be awarded. Winners advance to district, regional and jurisdictional competition.

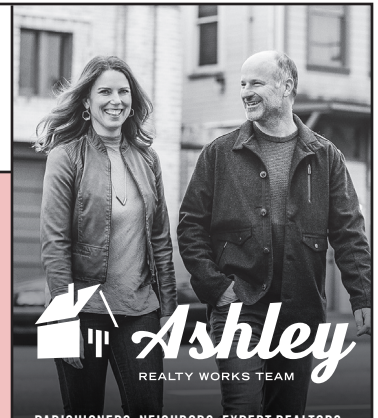

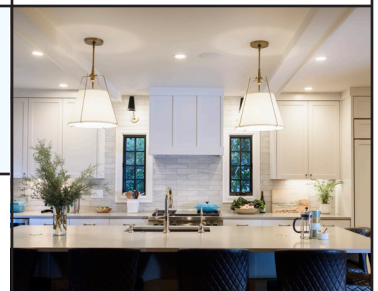
