FR. CARLOS PIEDRAHITA AT JUNE 24-25 MASSES

Rev. Fr. Carlos Piedrahita, P.S.S. will be visiting our parish next weekend to speak at all the Masses on behalf of Cross Catholic Outreach which was founded to create a meaningful link between parishes in America and the priests and nuns working in the Church overseas in the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Central and South America.

About Fr. Piedrahita

Father Carlos Piedrahita was ordained in 2013 for the Archdiocese of Hartford, CT. He joined the Diocese of Tyler, Texas. He was born in Medellin, Colombia. Before beginning his seminary studies, Fr. Carlos earned a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration and a Master's in Strategic Management of Costs and Finances at EAFIT University in Colombia. He studied Philosophy at the University of St. Thomas, Houston, TX and completed a Master's in Divinity at St. John's Seminary in Brighton, MA. He is a

candidate for a Sacred Theology License in Spirituality at Boston College, where he is writing his thesis on the Humanity of Christ in the works of St. Ignatius of Loyola and St. Teresa of Avila. He also received training as a Director of Spiritual Exercises and Spiritual Director at St. Beuno's Jesuit Spirituality Centre in North Wales, United Kingdom. He has served as a parochial vicar at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Waterbury, St. Paul Church and St. Augustin in Glastonbury, the Torrington Catholic Cluster, and St. Matthew Church in Forestville; as parish administrator of St. Mary Church in Newington; and as an assistant Master of Ceremonies of the Archdiocese. Fr. Piedrahita is currently a member of the faculty of Theological College, The National Seminary at The Catholic University of America in Washington, DC.

St. Kateri Tekakwitha (July 14), is known as the patroness saint of Ecology and the Environment, as well as Indigenous People. Because of The Madeleine's commitment to care for God's creation, we are recognized as Oregon's first St. Kateri Habitat Site – embodying the spirit of St. Kateri through the caretaking of our beautiful grounds.

Our “official” patroness is St. Mary Magdalene (July 22) – the patron saint of converts and women, and a legendary example of God's mercy and grace. She was there at the foot of the cross when Jesus died—and said to be the first to encounter the risen Christ in the garden. It is fitting that St. Mary Magdalene first thought Jesus was the “gardener.” For Christ is the master gardener—bringing forth the first fruits of the Resurrection and cultivating new life in all who believe.

More information to come on these celebrations, which will culminate on Saturday, July 22, after the 5:00 pm Mass.

The Madeleine's Laudato Si' Circle and Care for Creation Ministry have joined with U. S. based recycler, Terracycle, to offer our parish, school, and community opportunities to responsibly recycle specific items (primarily plastics) not generally handled at curbside. Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Do not include garbage or items not specifically mentioned in the descriptions.
- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.

By The Numbers

1 Giving History. So you don't have to dig through your bank records, these green bars show how much you've given each year, averaged by month for simplicity. Parish Offertory, Second Collections and Capital Repair gifts are used here. **These bars do NOT include Old Church Capital Campaign giving or pledges.**

2 Parishioner Average Giving. For context, we've provided the average monthly contribution per contributing parish family over each of the past 5 years.

3 Contact information. We have included what we have for your current contact information. See an error or a phone or email missing? Just make the correction when you send in your commitment card!

4 Suggested 2023-24 monthly amount. This is an amount for you to consider for your 2023-24 giving. It reflects the greater of your prior year monthly average plus our requested 7% increase, or the parish average. It's just a suggestion...we are grateful for any amount.

5 Your Commitment. Here, we list your commitment for the coming year. The amount here is intended to cover not only your Parish Offertory, the main fund that our parish runs on, but Second Collections and Capital Repair Fund also. **This does NOT include any gifts to our Old Church Project Capital Campaign.**

6 Method of payment: We are really hoping people will experience the convenience of automatic electronic payments this year. Complete instructions are on the back of your commitment card.
