# MUSIC NOTES TO THE PART OF THE

# ST. KATERI AND THE MADELEINE CONNECTION

This weekend, we honor a Saint that many are unfamiliar with—in fact, most can't even pronounce her name. Saint Kateri Tekakwitha (see what I mean) is the first female Native American and First Nations saint—and is known as the patron saint of ecology, Indigenous Peoples, and care for creation. Relatively new to the world of Saints, St. Kateri was canonized by Pope Benedict in October of 2012.

Born in 1656, in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon, New Netherland (near Auriesville, New York), St. Kateri was the child of a Mohawk father and Catholic mother. At the age of four, her family perished from a smallpox outbreak-leaving St. Kateri an orphan and physically weakened, scarred, and partially blind. As a young girl, she encountered Jesuit missionaries and was baptized in 1676 with the name Catherine (Kateri in Mohawk), in recognition of St. Catherine of Siena. Because of her religious convictions, St. Kateri became her village outcast and eventually took refuge in the Mission of Francis Xavier near Montreal. She led a life full of prayer and penitence, taking care of the poor and sick, and living by the words, "Who can tell me what is most pleasing to God that I may do it." For her kindness and faith, she was often referred to as the "Lily of the Mohawk." St. Kateri also inflicted physical punishments upon herself, thinking this would bring her closer to God. Unfortunately, these took a toll on her already frail body, and she died at just 24 years old. Those who witnessed her death said that within minutes her smallpox scars disappeared, and her skin became radiant. Tradition says her last words were, "Jesus, Mary, I love you."

To connect the dots between St. Kateri, Ecology and The Madeleine, it is important to note that St. Kateri's ancestors believed in relationships built upon respect, responsibility, and especially gratitude for all life. Because of this, they were good stewards of the land and wildlife, believing there was no separation between man and nature. In fact, it is said that St. Kateri often went into the woods to speak to God—listening to Him through the voices of nature.

With our parish commitment to care for God's creation, The Madeleine naturally lends itself to a spiritual connection with St. Kateri. In fact, The Madeleine was recently recognized as an official "Saint Kateri Habitat"-a program developed by the Saint Kateri Conservation Center reflecting the values of St. Kateri. As part of its mission, the program emphasizes caring for all God's creation by restoring and managing land in ways that praise God. Walking the grounds of our beautiful campus, I am sure you will agree that The Madeleine is a living example of St. Kateri—where God, people, and nature are connected.

Please join us on Saturday, July 22 as we celebrate Saints Kateri and Mary Magdalene with Mass, followed by great food, fun music, and fellowship in The Madeleine Courtyard—our own St. Kateri Habitat. It is the perfect backdrop to welcome our new Priest Administrator, Father Bonaventure. St. Kateri—pray for us!




