The above verse from a song by Edwin Hatch briefly summarizes the Sacrament of Confirmation. The Sacrament of Confirmation completes a person's initiation into the Catholic Faith and Community. It is the fulfillment of Jesus' promise to send the Spirit and guide us into all truth.

As God breathes the Spirit into us in Baptism and Confirmation, we are filled with grace and gifted with new energy to be faithful followers of Jesus. Both the gifts and fruits of the Spirit flow into us and can transform our lives from Ordinary to Extraordinary. What is asked of us is a "yes."
