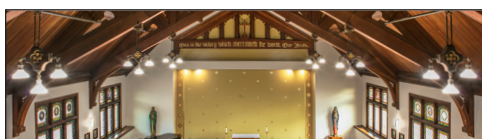

ARCHDIOCESAN SEMINARIAN APPEAL

A note from Fr. Bonaventure:

It's just over ten years since I finished seminary and was ordained to the priesthood. I have to be honest, and I admit my biases, but the life of the priesthood is the best thing in the world. And the best part of being a priest is being able to have a front row seat to witness God's love for His people, especially in the sacraments. It's costly...and I don't mean the many thousands of dollars, but the other more human costs. But it's also worth it.

I also think of the many times in my life, I've experienced God's love through a priest. God shows up in priestly encounters, if we're open to it, and that is worth everything.



I hope you will consider supporting these individuals who are willing to step into this role, which God is inviting them to prepare for. I can tell you for sure there are a lot

of pressures driving them away...but something sustains them. If we're lucky, one of them will very likely be your pastor in a few years, or will celebrate a loved one's wedding or funeral. If I'm lucky, one will give me last rites when it's time.

They need our help. Please pray for them, but if you can help to cover the cost, that's a big help, too. I assure you, if they had to go \$250,000 into debt, they would never, on the salary of a priest, cover the cost!

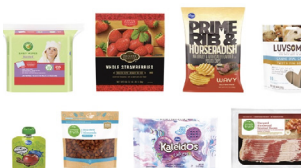

Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Do not include garbage or items not specifically mentioned in the descriptions.
- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.

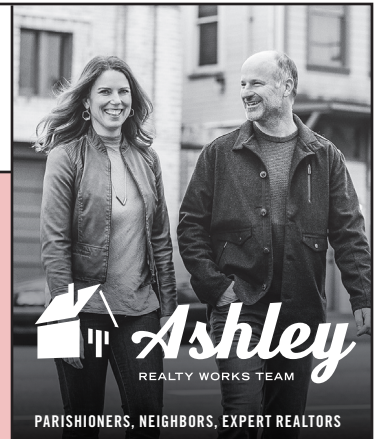

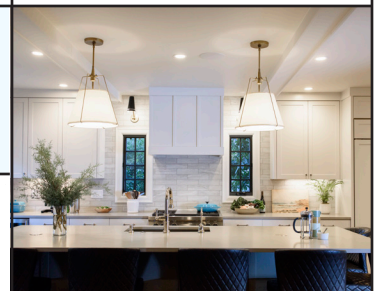
