By The Numbers

1 Your Giving History. So you don't have to dig through your bank records, these green bars show how much you've given each fiscal year (July 1–June 30), averaged by month for simplicity. Parish Offertory, Second Collections and Capital Repair gifts are used here. **These bars do NOT include Old Church Capital Campaign giving.**

2 All-Parishioner Average Giving. For context, we've provided the average monthly contribution per contributing parish family over each of the past 5 fiscal years.

3 Contact information. We have included what we have for your current contact information. See an error or a phone or email missing? Just make the correction when you send in your commitment card!

4 Suggested 2024-25 monthly amount. This is an amount for you to consider for your 2024-25 giving. It reflects the greater of your prior year monthly average plus our requested 7% increase for this fiscal year, or the parish average. It's just a suggestion...we are grateful for any amount.

5 Your Commitment. Here is where you enter your commitment for the coming year...intended to cover not only your Parish Offertory, the main fund that our parish runs on, but Second Collections and Capital Repair Fund also.

6 Method of payment: We are really hoping people will experience the convenience of automatic electronic payments this year. Complete instructions are on the back of your commitment card.

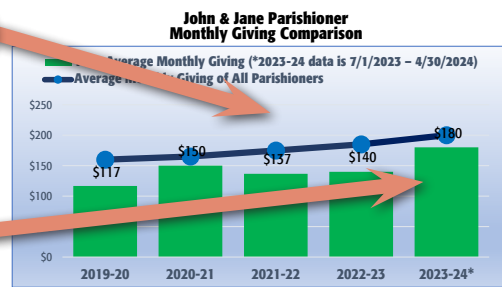

GREG MISTELL

Funeral Mass—Saturday, June 15, 11:00 am

A Funeral Mass for Greg Mistell will be held on Saturday, June 15, 11:00 am at The Madeleine. Praying of the Rosary begins at 10:30 am.

Gregory John Mistell lost his yearlong battle with acute myeloid leukemia on May 10, 2024. Per his request, Greg made it home from the hospital for the last 9 hours of his life. Cherished husband of Lisa O’Leary-Mistell, they shared 24 incredible years together. Greg was born in Mount Clemens, MI. The son of Genevieve and John Mistell, he attended Mount Louis Catholic elementary school in Mount Clemens, Bloomfield Hills High School, then attended 3 1/2 years of university in Michigan but left before he graduated to be with his mother when his dad was sick.

He was forever grateful for his refined training by a skilled French baker in Seattle, which led him into a successful baking career. A lifelong love of baking walked him through bakeries, schools, and bakery competitions, all of which contributed to what he insisted was the best baking of his life at Fleur de Lis Bakery in our very own neighborhood.

Greg was a member of Madeleine Parish, Hollywood Boosters, and Riverside Golf Club. Golf was an

integral part of his life and something he enjoyed sharing with his family. He loved camping, trips to Europe, gardening at home, spontaneous trips to the beach, Mount Hood and Bend, woodworking, playing his Martin guitar, listening to music for hours on end, movies, baking, cooking for friends and family, driving the back roads, solitary trips to LA twice a year to visit his son Ryan, walking his beloved dog Daisy, but his greatest love was being a father and husband and spending time at home together. He took great pride in making sure his family was always loved and cared for. He will be remembered for his honor, excellence, and integrity. Greg was a fierce protector, passionate about anything he loved. He had a wicked humor that could be so dry, unless you had the same kind of humor, it was sometimes missed. He had an unmatched work ethic and was an inspiration for many of us. His devotion, love, care and dedication to his family, close friends and Fleur de Lis will be his legacy. Moving forward without him—both at the bakery and at home—will be challenging for all of us, but using him as an inspiration and believing he is with us in spirit at all times, we will do our



best to honor him.

Preceded in death by his son Johnny, his parents John and Genevieve Mistell, his father-in-law Bill, and his sister, Carol. He is survived by his soulmate Lisa, his sister Sherry, her husband Doug, his brother-in law Stan, his nephews Jeff, David, Jim, Mark, John (their wives and children), his beloved children Emily, Holly, Alisen, Ryan, and Mikey, and his grandchildren Julia and Josephine. Greg would want nothing more than that we continue to live this life with all the love, laughter, and warmth that he shared with us.

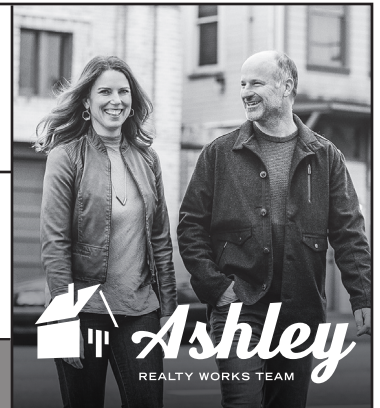

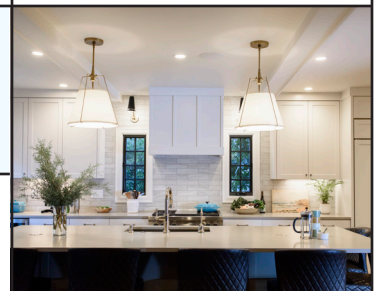
