Those of you who are in the book club may remember reading *With God in Russia*. I was deeply inspired by this autobiography. I read recently that Fr. Walter Cizek's cause for canonization has been started. I also came across a book (Walter J. Cizek, SJ, *Triple Novena, Extraordinary Experiences, Powerful Prayer*) edited by Marc Lindeijer, SJ, and Rosemary Stets, OSF. They knew Fr. Cizek after his return from 23 years in prisons in Russia. The book offers a triple novena with his reflections

from 3 settings: Lubyanka Prison, the work camps, and the town of Norilsk.

I invite you to pray these novenas with me and ask for the intercession of Fr. Walter Cizek in praying for peace in our country and our world. I will lead 27 days of these prayers beginning on November 27 and ending on December 23 via Zoom at 6:30 pm.

The Madeleine's Laudato Si' Circle and Care for Creation Ministry have joined with U. S. based recycler, Terracycle, to offer our parish, school, and community opportunities to responsibly recycle specific items (primarily plastics) not generally handled at curbside. Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.
