We realize sometimes it can be tough to get the family to Mass on Sunday mornings. On Saturday evening it can be a challenge to attend Mass, then get home and feed a hungry family. We have a solution.

On March 1, we’re debuting Madeleine Saturday Supper, which we hope to roll out monthly. The idea would be to provide a delicious, cost effective supper for Madeleine families to take home after Mass.

This month, we’re offering authentic, Vietnamese Pho, packaged up to take home for your evening dinner. Just \$10 per bowl with tofu, \$12 per bowl with chicken or beef brisket, all with Vegetarian broth. Proceeds this month to benefit buildings and grounds initiatives on The Madeleine campus.

Palm Sunday: An MC's Perspective

If Holy Week allows us to spiritually re-live the Passion of Christ, then Palm Sunday is a time of great optimism. Jesus enters Jerusalem, simply clothed in love, mercy, and forgiveness. We are gripped by the feeling that we are about to witness something truly remarkable, though we can't be certain what or why. Having endured centuries of waiting, the joy is overwhelming.

The envoy of Holy Week, Palm Sunday is also a relatively simple liturgy. The Parish Hall is prepared with ambo, aspersorium (the urn filled with Holy Water), and tables covered with palms. The thurible is prepared, the charcoal lit and is left hanging at the altar. The altar candles are lit. Since processions will occur to and from the church, the opening (and closing) of doors is coordinated with Hospitality Ministers. Music and the

procession of the choir is coordinated with the Music Director. Procession routes may vary depending on the Mass.

And my favorite part, briefing the altar servers who, more than anyone, feel the day's specialness. Leading the procession with crucifix and candles, they are the colt bearing the Light of the World into Jerusalem.

Simple. And when Mass is finished and all arrangements put back into order, it's time to reflect on the gift given, the gift received. Interested in playing your part? Highlights of your Itinerary:

▶ **Assisi**—After arriving in Rome, we begin our Pilgrimage in Assisi, Italy—the heart of the Umbria region and the hometown of St. Francis. With its picturesque cobblestone streets and geranium window baskets, Assisi IS Italy! We will spend 3 nights in Assisi, where we will visit the Basilica of St. Francis, pray at the tomb of St. Francis and view the famous Giotto frescoes depicting his life. We will also visit the Basilica of St. Clare where Francis was called to rebuild his church. Finally, we will pray at the Church of St. Mary of the Angels, which houses the original church of St. Francis. There will be free time to enjoy the spirituality and beauty of Assisi and the surrounding area at your leisure. Optional day trip by train to Florence, Italy.

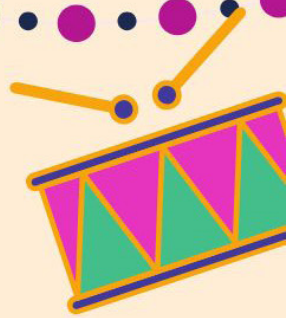
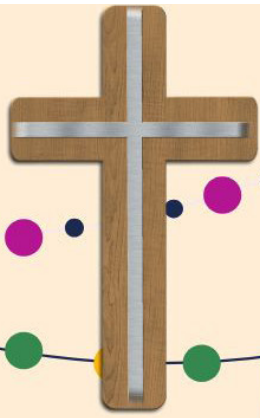
▶ **San Giovanni Rotondo**—Travel from Assisi to San Giovanni Rotondo for an overnight trip to celebrate the Feast of St. Padre Pio. Join thousands of Pilgrims in a candlelight procession and mass at the Sanctuary of St. Pio. As we travel along the beautiful Gargano Peninsula we will stop for mass at the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel and other holy sites as time allows. Our Pilgrimage continues in Rome, where we will spend the next several days immersed in this majestic city.

▶ **Rome**—While in Rome, we will celebrate the Jubilee Year of the Church (the Year of Hope) with pilgrims from all over the world. This is an opportunity of a lifetime! In addition to our scheduled itinerary we will have an opportunity to join in special activities specifically for the Jubilee Year. Among our scheduled activities, we will attend the Papal Audience at St. Peter's Basilica, with guided tours of the Basilica of St. Peter and the Sistine Chapel. We will also visit and celebrate Mass at the Catacombs of Priscilla, where the early Christians worshipped. Our Pilgrimage will also include guided visits to The Basilicas of St. Paul Outside the Walls, St. John Lateran and the exquisite Church of Santa Maria Maggiore. It is said that Pilgrims who walk through the doors of these Holy churches during a Jubilee Year receive special graces! We will also have an opportunity to see the Pantheon, Colosseum, Piazza Navona, and throw a coin in the Trevi Fountain before traveling back to the USA or to Dubrovnik, Croatia.

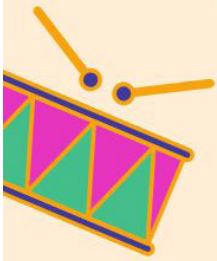
▶ **Optional Extension: Medjugorje & Dubrovnik**—We arrive in Dubrovnik and travel to Medjugorje—nestled in the hills of Bosnia- Herzegovina. Medjugorje is a place of peace and prayer like no other on earth. Our time in Medjugorje will include such activities as daily Holy Mass; climbing Cross Mountain and Apparition Hill for those that are able; attending talks with the visionaries (if available); or just spending time with the locals and sharing in the faith journey of others—a true spiritual experience. 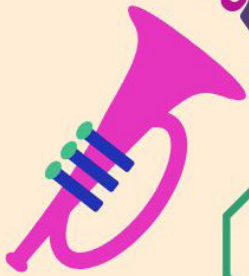

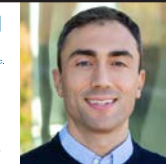

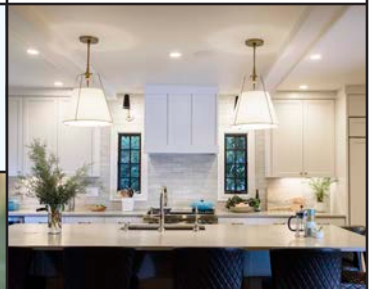
