This year, again, we're making a fresh start, a blank canvas. So even if you've sent us a

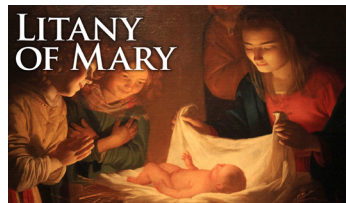


photo before, please send a new one this year.

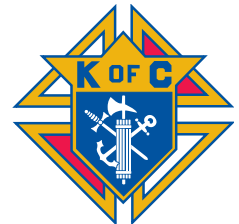
## Baptism Class

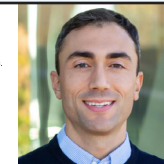
