Madeleine Saturday Supper: Pho To Go

May 31 • After 5:00 pm Mass • \$10–\$12 Per Bowl

We realize sometimes it can be tough to get the family to Mass on Sunday mornings. On Saturday evening it can be a challenge to attend Mass, then get home and feed a hungry family. We have a solution.

On May 31, we're continuing our wildly successful Madeleine Saturday Supper, which sold out in its March debut. A delicious, cost effective supper for Madeleine families to take home after Mass.

This month, we're offering authentic, Vietnamese Pho, packaged up to take home for your evening dinner. Just \$10 per bowl with tofu, \$12 per bowl with chicken, or with beef brisket and meatballs—all with vegetarian broth. Proceeds this month to benefit buildings and grounds initiatives on The Madeleine campus. *A note about the packaging: meals are provided in reusable, dishwasher- and microwave-safe containers.*

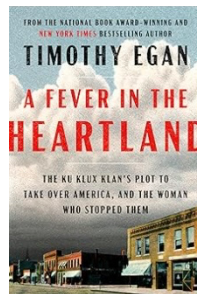
No Daily Masses June 2–6

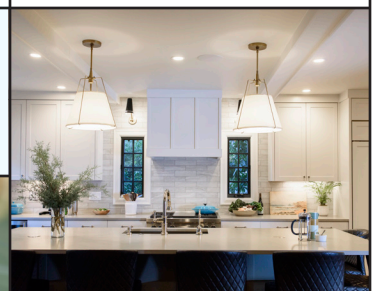

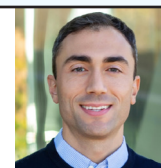
