Knights Of Columbus Silver Rose Tour, Monday

Monday, July 21 • 9:00 am • Rosary and Prayer Service • Main Church

Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose has been a Knights of Columbus tradition for 62 years. In 1960, groups of Columbian Squires in Mexico, Canada and the United States decided to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe by carrying a rose across North America from Canada to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico. In 2001 Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson addressed the effort in culture of life terms, referring to the Our Lady of Guadalupe—One Life, One Rose Program. He urged that it be expanded to every North American jurisdiction.

In recent years, the program has expanded from three to eight silver roses traveling the

western, central, and eastern corridors of North America, with Knights of Columbus from Canada to Mexico carrying the roses from destination to destination, and finally to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico.

Every stop along the route of the Silver Rose Pilgrimage is an occasion for prayer and spiritual renewal centered on the rosary. English and Spanish booklets containing recommended prayers, scripture readings and a litany accompany the Silver Rose. The Madeleine Council will be hosting the Silver Rose Icon on July 21 at 9:00 am with a Rosary and prayer service in the main church.

Feast of St. Mary Magdalene

TODAY, WE CELEBRATE OUR PATRON-ESS, ST. MARY MAGDALENE, a friend of Jesus who stood by his side all the way to the cross. All four Gospel accounts say that Mary Magdalene accompanied Jesus to his crucifixion. She was, according to these texts, the first person, or among the first, to witness the empty tomb. Both Mark and John say that Jesus not only first appeared to Mary Magdalene after he rose from the dead, but also that he commissioned her to be the first to announce the Good News. This is one reason why she is known as the “Apostle to the Apostles.”

SCAM ALERT

More emails and texts fraudulently claiming to be from Father Bonaventure have been received by some parishioners and staff.

Email and text message scams such as this are proliferating not only in our Archdiocese, but nationwide.

First, the victim receives a fake text or email from a fraudster impersonating Fr. Bonaventure saying, "I need a favor from you," or similar.

If the victim replies to the text, the fraudster may ask for iTunes or Google Play gift cards or other difficult to trace/easy to redeem methods, for some need that sounds charitable or legitimate. Problem is, it's neither.

A few ways to know it's fraud:

- ▶ Father B—or anyone on your parish or school staffs—**will never ask you to purchase gift cards and send them the numbers.**
- ▶ **The email address or text number is wrong.** Fr. Bonaventure will only send emails via his parish address: fatherbonaventure@themadeleine.edu
- ▶ **Also note:** sometimes these texts are faked to be from other people you may know...parishioners, friends, etc.
If you are ever in doubt as to whether a request for money or assistance is legitimate, call the School or Parish Office during work hours.


