

# In Memoriam

THE MADELEINE FAMILY REMEMBERS

## Fernando Red Dimaculangan

Funeral Mass • Wednesday, August 6, 11:00 am

A Funeral Mass will be celebrated for Fernando Dimaculangan on Wednesday, August 6, 11:00 am at The Madeleine.

Fernando Red Dimaculangan, or "Jun" as he was known to most because he was a junior, was born in Manila, Philippines on February 5, 1951 to Fernando Buenavista Dimaculangan, Sr., a lawyer, and Zenaida Red Dimaculangan, a stay-at-home mother. He was raised in a close-knit family with two brothers, Jesus and Joselito, and sister Alice. Jun also had many cousins that he maintained a close relationship with into adulthood.

He graduated high school from the University of the East, and took engineering courses at St Louis University in Baguio City but discovered engineering just wasn't the right career path. Before a young, adventure-seeking Jun could get into too much trouble trying to find his way, a beloved uncle drove Jun to Subic Naval Base in the Philippines to enlist with the United States Navy.

Jun married his childhood sweetheart and neighbor, Theresa (Teri), in 1976. Together they raised their only child, Trisha, in Oak Harbor, Washington where Jun had a successful career as a parachute rigger.

After 20 years in the military, Jun and Teri moved to Portland, Oregon where Trisha was enrolled in nursing school. Jun took

a job with the United States Postal Service, and the couple's life in Portland brought them so much joy with many friends and family members in the area. Trisha married Chris Mumm and with that brought two grandchildren, Henry and Sydney. Jun's favorite activity was spending time with Henry and Sydney, but he also enjoyed travelling, cooking, home improvement projects, working with bonsai plants, and music (especially if it was Pink Floyd or The Doors and played at loud decibels).

Teri's unexpected death in 2017 was devastating for Jun and their family, and Jun's health began to slowly decline. Visits from his beloved grandchildren, nieces, nephews as well as his caregiver and friend, Nati, brought Jun much strength in his last years.

Jun passed away peacefully in his sleep on July 16, 2025.

## TIPS FOR GREEN LIVING

**Vegetable patches and flower gardens** both require care, sunlight and water. There are many ways to save water. First, it is more efficient to wait until evening to water your plants. The dampness of the night and the lack of sun will allow the water to penetrate into the soil instead of evaporating. There is also a very efficient system that respects the rate at which the ground absorbs water: the drip system, which uses much less water, about 10 times less. To install this kind of watering system, just get a perforated garden hose that distributes water at the base of the plants.

**If you're thinking of buying a new boat,** you can make an environmentally-friendly choice. Electric boats are quieter and do not emit any greenhouse gases. There are also solar-powered boats, which generally have an average speed of 10 km/h and offer the advantage of not damaging the flora and fauna on shore. There are many boating choices that will preserve both the environment and your health: a pedalo, canoe, kayak, sailboat or rowboat. These types of watercraft give you an opportunity to observe and enjoy nature without disturbing it.
