**In this Sunday's Gospel, we find that Jesus "...went around all of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the gospel of the Kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people." In December, through your gifts, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul was able to proclaim the good news of the kingdom to the poor, by assisting 26 families, providing 403 lbs. in food from the pantry, plus 16 food cards and \$838.58 for utility and rent bills.
