## Big Change to Second Collections: Archdiocese-Wide Universal Church Appeal

*Your Gift, Your Choice, Our Shared Mission*

This year, the Archdiocese is combining nearly all of the former national second collections into one streamlined Universal Church Appeal, to occur at Masses the weekend of July 12, 2026. To quote from the Archdiocesan memo announcing the change,

“Beginning in 2026, we will shift from today’s crowded and fragmented second collection landscape to a more focused, high-impact approach: three major archdiocesan campaigns, down from a patchwork of 14+ collections. This streamlined model gives parishes more control over their weekends, clearer messaging to parishioners, and a stronger sense of shared mission across the archdiocese. This shift is designed to increase participation, simplify messaging, and strengthen our collective capacity to fund the ministries most vital to our mission to witness to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. This new approach reflects the thoughtful recommendation of the Presbyteral Council, whose counsel played a key role in shaping this path forward.”

The primary way to make these donations will be at the Archdiocesan website, but we’ll investigate to see if there’s a way for folks who prefer checks to participate. The theme is “your gift, your choice, our shared mission,” and it’s as easy as 1-2-3: explore the needs, direct your gift to the ministries you choose and for what amount, and submit with confidence—the

Archdiocese will forward your donation to the respective organizations.

There will still be separate weekends for three local collections: Archbishop’s Catholic Appeal, Seminarian Appeal, and Catholic Charities, and parishes have freedom to run their own second collections if desired, but those are expected to be exceedingly rare.

The Madeleine's Laudato Si' Circle and Care for Creation Ministry have joined with U. S. based recycler, Terracycle, to offer our parish, school, and community opportunities to responsibly recycle specific items (primarily plastics) not generally handled at curbside. Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.
