## Welcome Fr. Charles Ramirez, Presiding at Masses This Weekend

Please welcome Fr. Ramirez, who will speak at all the Masses on behalf of Cross Catholic Outreach, which was founded to forge a stronger and more supportive link between parishes in America and the priests and nuns serving the poor in the Caribbean, Africa, Southeast Asia, and Central and South America.



Fr. Ramirez graduated from California Polytechnic State University in 1972 with a degree in Marketing, Public Relations, and Journalism. He began his career in TV, producing the evening news before becoming a field reporter for KXTV-TV Channel 10 in Sacramento. He discerned

the priesthood, profoundly impacted by a Catholic Charismatic Renewal and an internship at St. Viviana's on skid row in Los Angeles, where he encountered God among the poor.

Fr. Ramirez attended St. John's Seminary in Camarillo, CA, and was ordained for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in September 1987. He retired as Pastor of Our Lady of the

Assumption in June 2023
