

Laudato Si News & Meeting Dates

Solar, wind, batteries and transportation are taking off dramatically and will be sufficient to level off greenhouse gas emissions to avoid the worst climate damage, if we push.

As Bill McKibben shows in his new book, "Here Comes the Sun": "Something staggering is occurring on our planet, something that wasn't foreseen. It is entirely possible that historians will look back on these few years and note them for [something else]. But if we're lucky they'll be recalled as the moment we took a decisive turn toward the sun. ...June and July 2023...seem to be the months...when we started putting up a gigawatt's worth (which is to say a coal or nuclear power plant worth) of solar panels every day...by Northern Hemisphere's summer 2024, when we once again crushed temperature records, we were putting up a gigawatt of solar panels every 18 hours."

Lenten Fasting & Abstinence— guidelines from the Archdiocese

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are

binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own sui iuris Church.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the “paschal fast” to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Each Lent, Catholic families across the country unite to put their faith into action through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Through CRS Rice Bowl, families learn about how our sisters and brothers across the globe overcome hardships like hunger and malnutrition, and how through Lenten alms, we have the power to make the world a better place for all.

Rice Bowls are available in the church. Please be generous during Lent, then return them to the church on Holy Thursday.
