Parent-Led Confirmation... Please Let Us Know Your Thoughts

The Madeleine Parish is currently gauging interest in a Parent-led model of Confirmation preparation for the 2026-27 school year.

What this would look like:

- Parents cover a set of required lessons with their child before the Confirmation mass which is usually sometime in the Spring. Parents receive instructions to purchase materials upon registration.
- Parents and Confirmandi meet as a class once a month for support with lessons, community building, and small group conversations.
- Confirmandi attend a Confirmation retreat

offered by The Madeleine sometime before the sacrament.

- Parents and students attend at least one Mystagogy meeting sometime after the Confirmation Mass to reflect on the sacrament as a class.

We plan to return to offering an in-person, catechist-led model in the 2027-28 school year.

Dear Parishioners,

July 1 begins my fourth year of pastoral care of The Madeleine, which Archbishop Sample has graciously entrusted to me. It is a continued blessing to have been sent here.

One thing I am interested in enhancing in the culture of our parish is a collaborative and transparent administration of our resources. Even though we have distinct roles, it is clear that it is our church—yours and mine. In the next few months, I am hoping to share with you work that the staff, Buildings and Grounds Committee, Finance Committee, and the Pastoral Council are assembling to better collaborate on the care of our parish.

The first will be a **Campus Care Plan** focusing on preserving and maintaining our historic campus. Along with the Buildings and Grounds Committee and some hired expertise, Deacon Mike O'Mahoney has been taking a serious look at the buildings entrusted to us. I look to share with you a plan to invest and care for our campus.

Second will be a **Financial Stewardship Plan**. An important part of understanding our parish will be to understand our financial situation. When our business manager, My Schoning, closes the books on this fiscal year, with the input from the Finance Committee we will take the opportunity to let you know what our financial situation looks like...historically, for next fiscal year, and for the foreseeable future.

Third will be a **Pastoral Plan** that I and the Pastoral Council have been working on, which will describe the pastoral needs we see and how our parish's pastoral energies will be spent for the upcoming year, and with a view to the next three to five years.

Finally, we are planning a new event that I hope to be an annual fixture here...our **Stewardship Commitment Weekend** on September 19-20. Prior to that event, you will receive our annual Stewardship Letter with which to consider your financial commitment to our beloved parish. I plan to use that weekend to give thanks to God for the blessings The Madeleine Parish has been for several generations and to pray with you for the grace to care for her so that she may continue to serve many generations to come.

I wish you all a very blessed summer! And I hope to see you at the celebration of our patroness saint, Feast of St. Mary Magdalene, at the 5 pm Mass on July 18, with a potluck garden party after in the Parish Courtyard.

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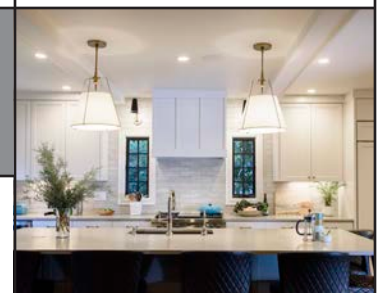
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
