Parent-Led Confirmation... Thoughts?

The Madeleine Parish is currently gauging interest in a Parent-led model of Confirmation preparation for the 2026-27 school year.

What this would look like:

- Parents cover a set of required lessons with their child before the Confirmation mass which is usually sometime in the Spring. Parents receive instructions to purchase materials upon registration.
- Parents and Confirmandi meet as a class once a month for support with lessons, community building, and small group conversations.
- Confirmandi attend a Confirmation retreat offered by The Madeleine sometime before the sacrament.
- Parents and students attend at least one Mystagogy meeting sometime after the Confirmation Mass to reflect on the sacrament as a class.

We plan to return to offering an in-person, catechist-led model in the 2027-28 school year.

THE MADELEINE FAMILY REMEMBERS

Sherrill Resch

Funeral Mass • Friday, July 31, 11:00 am

A Funeral Mass will be celebrated for longtime Madeleine parishioner Sherrill Resch on Friday, July 31, 11:00 am, at The Madeleine.

Sherrill Ann Resch, 90, a longtime resident of Portland, passed away at home on June 12, 2026.

Sherrill was born on January 30, 1936 in Plaquemine, Louisiana. She was the first born to Edward and Bernadette (Arbour) Barbier. Sherrill and her family moved to Vancouver, Washington in 1939. Her family included her sister Jeralyn, brother Edward, sister Kit, and brother Dean. Sherrill graduated from Providence Academy high school in 1953.

Sherrill followed a deep spiritual calling and entered the Sisters of Providence after graduating from high school. She moved into the convent, joined the sisters in their daily rhythm of prayer and community life, and trained for ministry in education. After her novitiate, she was missioned to Holy Family Parish in West Seattle, where she taught kindergarten and lived out the Sisters of Providence's commitment to faith, service, and trust in God's care.

It was at Holy Family that Sherrill befriended Father John Resch. In time, Sherrill and John discerned that religious life was not their ultimate calling, and were married in Astoria, Oregon, on July 9, 1969. They moved to San Francisco, where they started their family: Timothy was born in 1970, and Edward followed in 1974. In 1978, the family moved to Portland and settled in the Rock Creek neighborhood. Sherrill joined a bowling league and a ladies' golf group, and she was a regular volunteer for Meals on Wheels. She was active in the St. Pius X parish community, and the family home on the cul-de-sac became a frequent gathering spot for her sons and their friends.

While Sherrill was a sweet, kind soul – though she made a firm exception for



her dislike of the Dallas Cowboys – she possessed a fierce, quiet loyalty to those she loved. Beneath her gentle exterior lived a rare but brilliant streak of a daredevil and joker. Her fun-loving spirit earned her the affectionate nickname “Champagne Sherry” and fueled some truly epic pranks on her sons, most famously serving them Elmer's glue smores on April Fools' Day. She was entirely devoted to her family, balancing her deep faith with a lighthearted wit that left a lasting impression on everyone who truly knew her.

Sherrill was blessed with five grandchildren. Gunnar was the first, born in 1997, followed by Trennen in 2002. Stella arrived in 2008, and Zach and Alex rounded out the team in 2011. Sherrill was a devoted and joyful grandmother; no meal was complete without ice cream or cookies, and hugs and snuggles were always in abundant supply. She loved and excelled at being a grandmother.

Sherrill was preceded in death by her husband, John; her parents; and her brothers, Dean and Edward. She is survived by her son Timothy Resch and his wife, Dr. Pepita Payne, of Portland, Oregon; her son Edward Resch and his wife, Dr. Allyn Resch, of Jackson, Mississippi; her grandchildren Gunnar, Trennen, Stella, Zach, and Alex; her sisters Jeralyn and Kit; and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.

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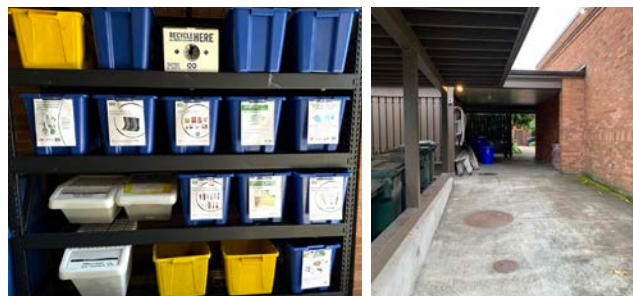

S. based recycler, Terracycle, to offer our parish, school, and community opportunities to responsibly recycle specific items (primarily plastics) not generally handled at curbside. Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.

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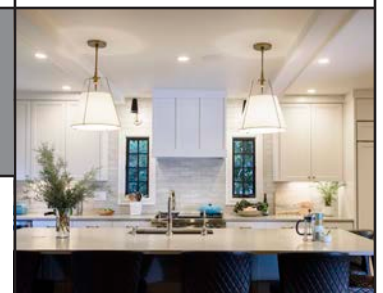
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
