Parent-Led Confirmation... Thoughts?

The Madeleine Parish is currently gauging interest in a Parent-led model of Confirmation preparation for the 2026-27 school year.

What this would look like:

- Parents cover a set of required lessons with their child before the Confirmation mass which is usually sometime in the Spring. Parents receive instructions to purchase materials upon registration.
- Parents and Confirmandi meet as a class once a month for support with lessons, community building, and small group conversations.
- Confirmandi attend a Confirmation retreat offered by The Madeleine sometime before the sacrament.
- Parents and students attend at least one Mystagogy meeting sometime after the Confirmation Mass to reflect on the sacrament as a class.

We plan to return to offering an in-person, catechist-led model in the 2027-28 school year.

OCIA Candidates and Catechumens— What's the Difference?

While you might hear the two terms used interchangeably at times, there is a difference!

Catechumens are those who are not baptized and seeking to become Catholic. They begin their preparation—known as the Pre-Catechumenate—no less than one year before they enter the Catechumenate. They then undergo formation and a series of rites with the parish community before receiving the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil Mass. If you are not baptized and want to know more, reach out to our OCIA team now!

Candidates are those who were baptized Christian but not Catholic and are seeking to come into Full Communion with the Catholic Church. They participate in formation to discern and learn more of the specific teachings of the Catholic faith while also participating in the life of the parish. Candidates can come into the Church as soon as they are ready, during any season. If you're baptized and believe you need to wait until next Easter to come into the Church, you may be mistaken! 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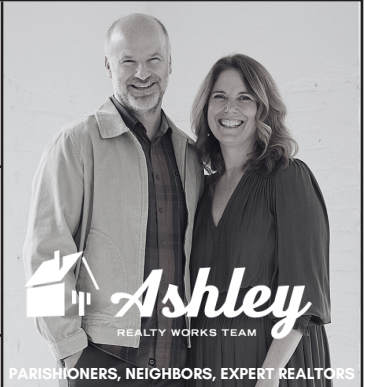


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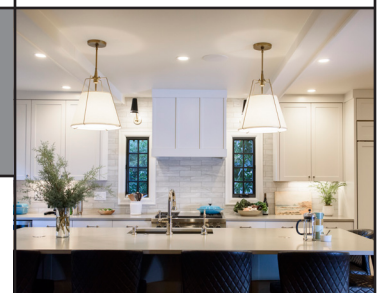
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
