Baptism

For Children in need of baptism beyond Second Grade

Children who have reached what is known as the “Catechetical age” (about seven or eight years old, past second grade) undergo a different process for baptism, known as the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults for Children, also called OCIA for Children or OCIC. If your child is beyond Second Grade, eight years or older, and seeking baptism in the Catholic Church, please email Lauren Craig for more information.

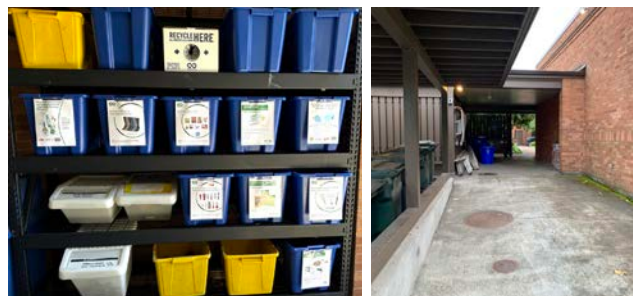

The Madeleine's Laudato Si' Circle and Care for Creation Ministry have joined with U. S. based recycler, Terracycle, to offer our parish, school, and community opportunities to responsibly recycle specific items (primarily plastics) not generally handled at curbside. Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Do not include garbage or items not specifically mentioned in the descriptions.
- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.

SCAM ! ALERT

More emails and texts fraudulently claiming to be from Father Bonaventure have been received by some parishioners and staff.

Email and text message scams such as this are proliferating not only in our Archdiocese, but nationwide.

First, the victim receives a fake text or email from a fraudster impersonating Fr. Bonaventure saying, "I need a favor from you," or similar.

If the victim replies to the text, the fraudster may ask for iTunes or Google Play gift cards or other difficult to trace/easy to redeem methods, this time purporting to "surprise some of our wonderful staff members."

A few ways to know it's fraud:

- ▶ Father B—or anyone on your parish or school staffs—**will never ask you to purchase gift cards and send them the numbers.**
- ▶ **The email number or text number is wrong.** Fr. Bonaventure will only send emails via his parish address: fatherbonaventure@themadeleine.edu
- ▶ Also note: sometimes these texts are faked to be from other people you may know...parishioners, friends, etc.

If you are ever in doubt as to whether a request for money or assistance is legitimate, call the School or Parish Office during work hours.

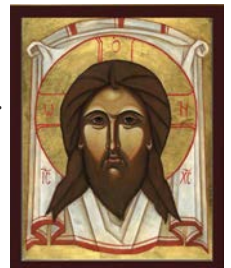
Begin the Journey of Iconography: Fall Class Registration Now Open

Registration is open for the Classical Iconography Institute's fall classes, held at St. Pius X and online. No art experience required for the following classes:

- ▶ **Beginning Level I** (in person on Monday afternoons and evenings)—Write your first icon - the Holy Face of Christ on the Cloth.
- ▶ **Byzantine Drawing I** (online on Tuesday afternoons)—Develop foundational drawing skills while learning how Byzantine iconographers have drawn faces for over a thousand years.
- ▶ **Calligraphy** (Saturdays in person)—Learn to properly form inscriptions in Greek, Latin and Cyrillic, and to read the most common inscriptions yourself.
- ▶ **Drawing Iconographic Hands** (Thursdays online)—Learn how to construct iconographic hands using the geometric principles that underlie the Byzantine tradition.

The Classical Iconography Institute is dedicated to teaching the ancient method of egg tempera iconography, emphasizing all along the way that painting an icon is an act of prayer. Students form a lively, supportive community grounded in shared faith.

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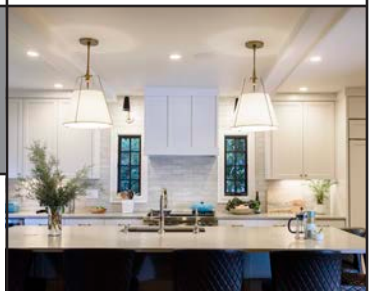
