Grounds

Deacon Mike and the Madeleine Clippers are making a huge difference by caring for the gardens of the Madeleine Parish and School. The Madeleine Parish even won an award for the beautiful roses!

Recycling

Jenny Hunter reports that The Madeleine has been participating in TerraCycle's recycling program since June of 2020. During that time, we have sent more than 1,037 pounds to TerraCycle to be recycled. Currently, we are collecting:

- ▶ All brands of oral care products
- ▶ All brands of drink pouches
- ▶ All clean socks
- ▶ All non-electric razors, blades and plastic packaging
- ▶ All brands of air and home health care bottles, lids, plus, cartridges
- ▶ Swiffer Dusters and Wet Jet pads
- ▶ All Kroger "Our Brands" flexible plastic packaging
- ▶ Sneakers: Also used pairs of athletic shoes are being collected for Got Sneakers.

There is a well-marked bin for these in the breezeway facing NE 23rd Ave.

Registration for 2026-27 is live!

Baptism

Baptism classes are offered once a month for parents, and godparents are encouraged to attend. Groups of parents and godparents meet together to learn about the sacrament and to share in this preparation with one another. Our next Baptism class will be offered on Sunday, September 6 at 1:30 pm in the Fireside Room. Registration in advance is required. For Children in need of baptism beyond Second Grade

Children who have reached what is known as the "Catechetical age" (about seven or eight years old, past second grade) undergo a different process for baptism, known as the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults for Children, also called OCIA for Children or OCIC. If your child is beyond Second Grade, eight years or older, and seeking baptism in the Catholic Church, please email Lauren Craig for more information.

RECYCLING PROGRAMS AT THE MADELEINE

Marked collection bins in the breezeway facing 23rd Ave.

The Madeleine's Laudato Si' Circle and Care for Creation Ministry have joined with U. S. based recycler, Terracycle, to offer our parish, school, and community opportunities to responsibly recycle specific items (primarily plastics) not generally handled at curbside. Terracycle has added more manufacturers to its program, and in turn, we have expanded our recycling offerings. Here is a current listing of what we are collecting. Please keep this in mind:

- ▶ Do not include garbage or items not specifically mentioned in the descriptions.
- ▶ Empty containers of contents. No need to wash first; ensure packaging is dry.



KROGER FLEXIBLE PLASTICS

All Kroger brand flexible plastic packaging can now be accepted. Includes Private Selection and Simple Truth brands as well.



DRINK POUCHES, ALL BRANDS

All drink pouches are accepted! Please remove as much of the remaining product as possible.



FABRIC CARE PRODUCTS & PACKAGING

From Tide, Gain, Downy, NBD and Dreft, including plastic components (dispensing cup, bag, nozzle, nozzle clip), and plastic packaging wrap, flexible plastic bags, rigid plastic tubs and lids, and Tide To Go pen.



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All brands of blades and razors (systems and disposable units, and replaceable-blade cartridge units), rigid plastic packaging, and flexible plastic bag packaging.



ORAL CARE PRODUCTS

All brands of used or empty oral care products, including toothpaste tubes, tooth brushes, and dental floss containers.



USED ATHLETIC SHOES (PAIRS ONLY)

We are pleased to offer for recycling or reuse any athletic shoes you no longer need. It's very important that only athletic shoes are provided, and only in pairs—we cannot accept any non-athletic footwear of any kind, including but not limited to dress shoes, heels, sandals, wedges, water socks, rain boots, crocs, or other non-athletic styles.

Griff Marshall

Funeral Mass • Saturday, September 12, 11:00 am

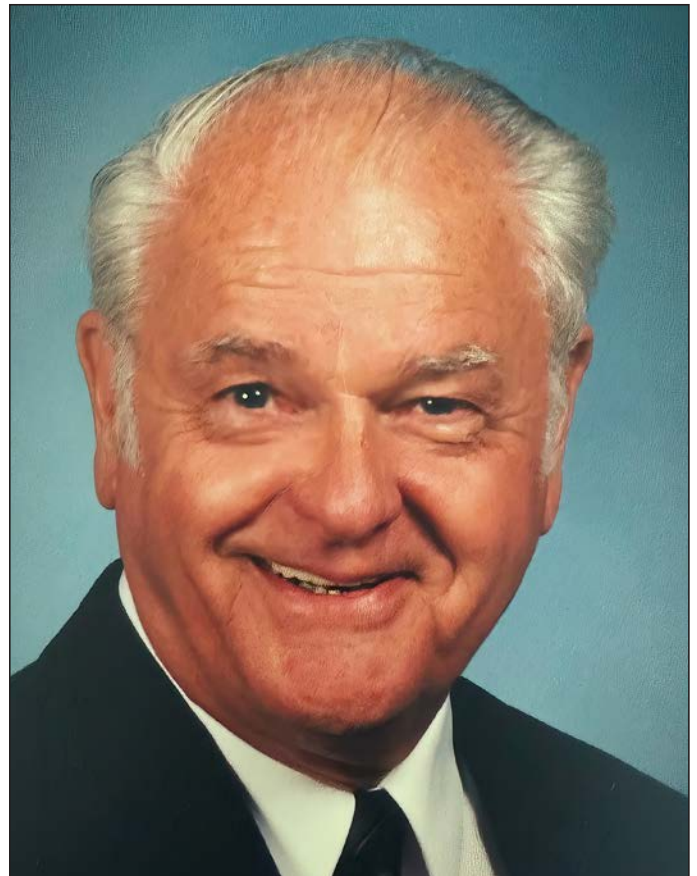
A Funeral Mass will be celebrated for longtime Madeleine parishioner Griff Marshall on Saturday, September 12, 11:00 am, at The Madeleine.

Griffith Macklin Marshall II was born on June 15, 1928. He was the third of five children born to Josephine Hodgson and Griffith Marshall. He was raised in Montreal, Quebec and attended St. Leo's Academy. Griff graduated in Commerce from McGill University where he was Intercollegiate Boxing Champion of 1948.

In 1951, he married Margaret Belisle. Shortly thereafter, they set off for Toronto, Ontario on the first of their moving adventures. In Toronto, Griff earned his Chartered Account (CA) and his MBA at the University of Toronto. Griff's career in finance would ultimately take the family from Toronto to Calgary, Alberta to Vancouver, B.C. Then on to San Francisco, Dallas and finally Portland, OR. In Portland, Griff was a consultant to, and later President of, Malarkey Roofing. He was fortunate to always enjoy work but made an easy transition to retirement in 1998.

Griff and Margaret were blessed with six loving children and were rightly teased about leaving their children behind in the wake of their moves. But no couple was more dedicated to maintaining their tight family bonds. They continued to regularly host great, loud, happy family holidays throughout Griff's lifetime. This example has been followed, and the extended Marshall family gathers with intention regularly. The bonds of the Marshall family he so dearly cherished will live on well after his passing. That is a legacy.

Griff and Margaret were in their 75th year of marriage when he passed away on June 14, 2026. He celebrated his 98th birthday surrounded by his family. Griff lived a remarkably long and full life. His and Margaret's lives were enriched by a very large extended family, their church communities, their bridge friends, their neighborhood friends and so many other affiliations. Griff loved social gatherings and a table crowded with food, friends and family. His departure leaves a big, empty seat at the head of the table. We will



miss him deeply.

He is survived by his wife Margaret, children Griff III(Barbara), Anne(Peter), Stewart(Sunny), Drew(Leslie), Johnson and Jennifer(Paul), grandchildren Griff IV(Erin), Brian(Monica), Valerie, Colin(Jacquelynn), Noah, Neil(Kelly), Adam, Charlie(Peter), Will(Ashley), Paul(Susan), Angela(Nick), Emilie, Henry, Emma, Marnie and Paul, and great-grandchildren Mackenzie Griffith V, Tessa, Benny, Brooklynn, Wesley, Olivia, Natalie, Madillynn, Nathaniel, Colton, Benton, Marshall, Maxwell and Elodie.

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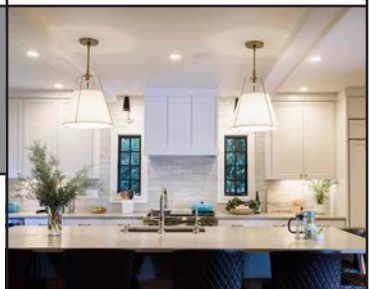
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
